# **BEE BOXES**

# Pros for Bees Nesting in the Natural Environment (not bee boxes)

- Natural nesting material breaks down naturally with time limiting disease and parasite issues.
- Natural nesting also provides habitats for butterflies and songbirds.
- Primary habitat for bees are stems and branches of trees, shrubs, wildflowers, leaf litter, undisturbed ground, dead wood, brush piles and rock piles.
- Clean water source is important for bees such as a birdbath or bowl with some stones.

### **Cons of Installing Bee Boxes**

- Boxes must be cleaned and emptied each year and the tubes and tray must be replaced with new
  ones. If you buy a mass-produced house, the tubes are glued in and cannot be replaced. If this is not
  done, parasitic wasps, bees, flies and mites can invade the house.
- Some pre-made houses have tubes that are too short to be of use.
- Tunnels can be too wide causing the bees to use too much energy mudding them up.
- Mass produced houses sometimes lack overhang to protect nests from water, leading to mite problems and often have string or a hook to attach the box allowing swing which can cause eggs to fall off.
- Sometimes mass-produced houses have metal or plastic parts which hold water which can cause bacterial and fungal problems in the nest.

# If You Really Want a Bee Box

- Make sure the house receives early morning sun, but is protected from peak hours of sun light
- Mount 5 to 8 feet high
- Tubes should be 6 inches long to insure a good number of female bees
- Tubes must be sealed at the back to stop parasitic insects from entering.
- Protect from wind and rain
- Near fresh water
- Native plants are near by
- House should be cleaned and new tray and tubes must be replaced annually
